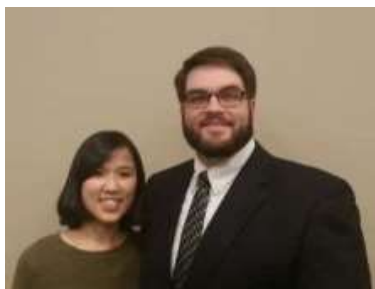


This is our test run for our e-bulletin before we officially launch. Thank you for being patient with us.
